

Classroom Expectations

- ❖ **Follow the rules and regulations of Coronado High School and the policies of EPISD.**
- ❖ **Respect:** Be respectful to yourself, the teacher and others. Respect the school property including students' desks. This is an equal opportunity classroom. Courtesy, respect and acceptable standards of behavior are to be expected at all times!
- ❖ **Be on time and be prompt:** Be in your assigned seat when it is time for class to begin.
- ❖ **Be prepared:** Bring all necessary materials to class: textbook, composition notebooks, pens (blue/black ink), pencils, highlighters, your own device **ONLY** when previously specified by the teacher, and positive attitude.
- ❖ **Be attentive:** Only one person should be speaking at a time. Raise your hand if you want to share something or have a relevant question to ask. Wait to be called upon before speaking.
- ❖ **Be responsible:** Bring your homework and do the assigned work during class. Respect time limits when using electronic devices. Remember that all late work will receive a maximum grade of 70%. Make sure your work has your name and date. **Papers with no name will get a ZERO.**
- ❖ **Be neat:** Keep your work and the classroom clean. Spiral paper with fringes will not be accepted.
- ❖ **Make up/redo work:** Any requested redo assignment for failed work are permitted. It is a **student's responsibility** to see me the day of receiving a graded, failed assignment to schedule time for tutoring and a retake. **The highest grade possible for a redo assignment is a 70%.** Only one retake/redo will be permitted per assignment.
- ❖ **Absences and Tardies:** A student is considered absent from class, if they arrive more than 10 minutes late to class. Arrangements must be made immediately upon the student's return to school to make up the missed work from any absence (**1 day absent = 1 day to make up**). **This is the student's responsibility!**
- ❖ **Tutoring:** Tutoring is on an "as needed" basis. Please see me in order to make tutoring arrangements.
- ❖ **Technology devices:** laptops, phones, tablets (or anything else that I have not listed) will be permitted to use in class **ONLY** at the direction of the teacher. If a device is used out of turn, it will be confiscated and dealt with on an individual basis. Technological devices are a useful tool in the German classroom and when used responsibly, make life in the German class easier and more fun.
- ❖ **Food/Drinks/Bathroom Use:** Food or drinks are **NOT allowed** in the classroom. Food/drinks and bathroom needs have to be taken care of during transition time.
